Commissioning Management

1. A Service that Facilitates the Constructor-Operator Transition

Stereau offers an additional support service dedicated to municipalities that operate their wastewater or drinking water treatment plants in-house: **management of the operational commissioning**. This service can start as early as the design phase of a plant and continue until the end of the warranty period.

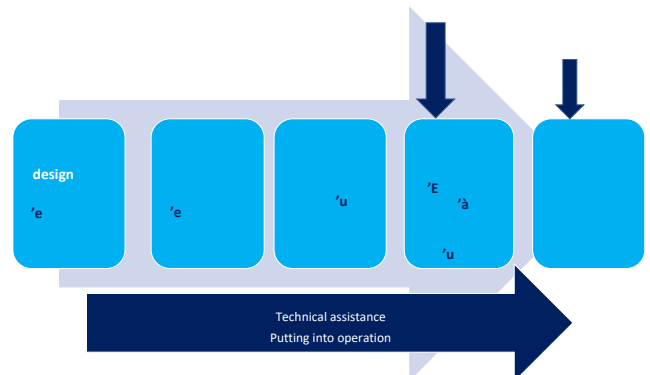

2. Customizable Services

- Operator training on processes
- Presence of a process expert alongside the operator until full mastery of the installations
